

Iranian-born Canadian singer and performer, Ramin Karimloo, is known as one of the most formidable talents in musical theatre. Critically acclaimed for his portrayal of leading roles - Jean Valjean in *Les Misérables* on Broadway (2014 Tony Award nominee) and London's West End as well as the Phantom in *Phantom of the Opera* in London, Ramin is a musical force unlike any other. He immortalized the role in the *25th Anniversary Concert of Phantom of The Opera* at The Royal Albert Hall, which was one of the most widely viewed shows in PBS history. He also originated the leading role in *Love Never Dies*, the sequel to *Phantom of the Opera*, for which he received an Olivier Award nomination. In addition, he played the role of Enjolras in the 25th Anniversary of *Les Misérables* at the O2 Arena in London. Most recently, Ramin starred as Gleb in *Anastasia* on Broadway and Anatoly in *Chess* at the Kennedy Center in Washington, DC. Ramin released a major label debut album, *Human Heart* (2012), and three EPs, *Within the Six Square Inch* (2007), *The Road to Find Out: East* (2014) and *The Road to Find Out: South* (2016).
