**(December 9, 2019 – Los Angeles, CA)** – Rock and Roll Hall of Fame inductee and Grammy®-winning singer and songwriter **OZZY OSBOURNE** has the **“#1 Rock Song in the Country”** this week as his single **“Under The Graveyard”** captures the #1 position on the Rock Radio Chart. This marks his third #1 on this chart and his first in 10 years; **“Under The Graveyard”** is his first new solo music in as many years. It also heralds **OZZY**’s forthcoming album, **ORDINARY MAN**, due out on **Epic Records** in **early 2020**.

Last month, **OZZY** unleashed **“Straight To Hell,”** the album’s second single featuring **Guns N’ Roses** guitarist **Slash**. **OZZY** also joined **Post Malone** to perform their record-breaking collaboration

**“Take What You Want”** in front of a sold-out audience at the Forum in Los Angeles (11/21) and to a national audience on ABC’s *American Music Awards* (11/24).

**ORDINARY MAN** was recorded in Los Angeles and features producer **Andrew Watt** on guitars, **Duff McKagan** (Guns N’ Roses) on bass and **Chad Smith** (Red Hot Chili Peppers) on drums.
