## CHRIS YOUNG

- NEW ALBUM: Chris Young's 9th studio album, Young Love & Saturday Nights, released March 22, 2024. The project, his first album since 2021's Famous Friends, features 18 songs, 15 of which Young had a hand in writing. Chris is the sole producer on three of the songs and sharing co-producer credits with longtime creative partners, Chris DeStefano and Corey Crowder. The new record has Chris turning things up emotionally, sonically, and stylistically, reaffirming his position as one of the most versatile and durable talents of his era.
- The album's title track and current single, which is Top 20 and rising at country radio, leans into David Bowie's "Rebel Rebel" signature guitar lick, making the legendary rocker a writer on the song alongside Ashley Gorley, Jesse Frasure and Josh Thompson. The steamy music video for "Young Love & Saturday Nights" was filmed at Old Hickory Beach in Hendersonville, Tenn., north of Nashville. Watch now HERE.
- NEW TRACK & VIDEO: Romantic new song "What She Sees In Me" produced by Young and written by Young with Christian Davis Stalnecker, Kyle Fishman, Ray Fulcher and Josh Hoge— along with the official music video, release on March 8. Other previously released/available now tracks from the new project include: "Right Now," "All Dogs Go To Heaven," "Double Down" and the Top 15 hit "Looking For You."
- TOUR: Young will embark on his Young Love & Saturday Nights Tour with headlining dates kicking off in April and spanning the Spring.
- Famous Friends, his 8th studio album, includes back-to-back chart toppers "At The End Of A Bar" with M10, nominated for a 2023 ACM Award, and his double platinum certified, multi-week No. 1 single "Famous Friends" w/Kane Brown, which topped Billboard's Country Airplay Songs chart for 2021 and was named ASCAP's song of the year for 2022.
- Chris has amassed more than 5 Billion career streams with 13 No. 1 singles as an artist and 11 as a songwriter. His 25 RIAA certified projects include multi-platinum tracks "I'm Comin' Over," "Famous Friends," "Tomorrow," "Gettin' You Home" and "Think of You."
- Recent TV includes Today Show, The Kelly Clarkson Show and the ACM, CMA and CMT Awards.
- CMT Awards trophies include Collaborative Video of the Year for "Famous Friends" (2021) and Performance of the Year for "Drowning" (2020).
- Inducted into the membership of the Grand Ole Opry in 2017.
- PODCAST: "The Quad with Chris Young" launched at the start of 2020 Chris and friends Josh, Hailey and Ryan discuss four topics: Sports, Music, Movies and a weekly Hot Take. With over 650k listening hours in 90 countries, guests have included Kane Brown, Israel Guttierez, Tyler Hubbard, Sabrina lonescu, Dusty Slay, Tracy Lawrence, Mitchell Tenpenny and Brad Paisley. Fans of the podcast often get previews and insights before they are shared anywhere else!
- In addition to an annual scholarship for recording industry students at MTSU in 2016, Chris funded the renovation of **The Chris Young Café**, an on campus teaching and performance venue for students. A new Tennessee Music Pathways marker was unveiled outside to mark Young's success.
