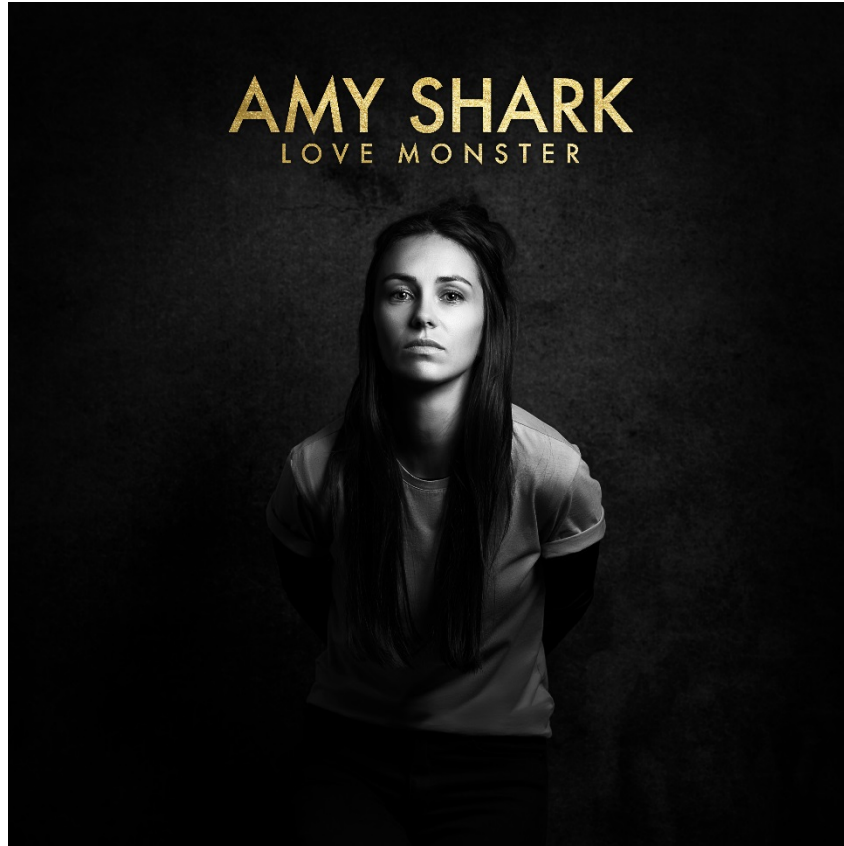


AMY SHARK RELEASES DEBUT ALBUM *LOVE MONSTER* TODAY

Gold Coast, Australia-based musician Amy Shark has hit the ground running with the enormous success of her brooding, coming-of-age single “Adore” (Click [HERE](#) to watch the music video), which is not only certified Triple Platinum in Australia, it was #1 on the Australian iTunes and Shazam charts, and came in at #2 on triple j’s Hottest 100. She has also previously toured with Vance Joy and Bleachers. This past fall, Amy Shark was also featured as one of Apple Music’s Up Next Artists, for which she released an Apple Music documentary short film, an exclusive interview with Beats 1’s Zane Lowe, and performed on CBS’ *The Late Late Show With James Corden*. NBC’s *Last Call With Carson Daly* also featured Amy Shark’s performance of “Adore” (Click [HERE](#)) and “Weekends” (Click [HERE](#)) filmed live at The Fonda Theatre in Los Angeles. Most recently, Amy performed “Adore” on *The Tonight Show Starring Jimmy Fallon*. Additionally, Amy’s latest single “I Said Hi” has seen massive success in Australia since its release. The track has reached #1 on Shazam’s Australia Hot 100 Chart, #1 on iTunes, #1 on the airplay chart, and reached the Top 15 on Spotify in Australia. “I Said Hi” has over 12 million Spotify streams, over 20 million worldwide streams to date, and the music video has over 3 million views (Click [HERE](#) to watch).
