(New York – August 27, 2021) Today, Beach Wave Sound / RCA Records artist **Destiny Rogers** releases a brand new single with accompanying visualizer “**Simon Say**” featuring **Flo Milli**.

“Simon Say” was produced by multi-Grammy Award winning and Producer of the Year nominated producers/songwriters **The Stereotypes** (Bruno Mars, Cardi B., Justin Bieber) who also co-wrote the song with Destiny Rogers, Flo Milli and Grammy nominated singer/songwriter Ant Clemons. On “Simon Say,” Destiny offers up a gorgeously understated anthem of empowerment. “One of the main messages I want to put out in my songs is the idea of being an independent woman and a boss bitch. ‘Simon Say’ is about knowing what you’re capable of, and never letting anyone hold you down” says Destiny.

“Simon Say” follows Destiny’s latest tracks “**What I Like**,” which was featured in Destiny’s **Jordan Brand** campaign, titled “**Delta of Destiny**” for the release of the Jordan Delta 2 shoe, and “**West Like**” featuring **Kalan.FrFr** on which Destiny pays loving homage to her West Coast and Latin roots.

Since first breaking through with her boldly confident but carefree single “Tomboy,” which has generated over 45 million views on YouTube ([Watch HERE](#)) and most recently covered by K-Pop super group **Black Pink’s Lisa** through a dance cover ([Watch HERE](#)) that has generated over 70 million views, Destiny Rogers has staked her claim as an artist to watch. Growing up in the Northern California town of Lodi, the 21-year-old multi-faceted musician taught herself to play guitar at age 10 and soon started writing and self-producing her own songs. Soon after the 2019 premiere of “Tomboy,” a track that recently hit #12 on Spotify’s Global Viral 50, Destiny’s spectacular rise has included touring the world and writing for heavy hitters such as **Alicia Keys**, **Khelani** and **G-Eazy**, all while discovering a new sound that transcends genres to irresistible effect.

Destiny Rogers is currently in the studio working on new material. Prior to “West Like” featuring Kalan.FrFr, Destiny released a reworking of “Tomboy” feat. Coi Leray, and linked up with Coi for a special TikTok to the song which was reposted on [Instagram](#) and praised by **Kim Kardashian West**. In addition, K-Pop superstar **B.I** released his global single, “Got It Like That” featuring Destiny Rogers with **Tyla Yaweh** which debuted at #1 on Spotify’s K-Pop X-Overs chart and has generated over 4 million views on YouTube ([Watch HERE](#)).

About Destiny Rogers:

21-year-old Destiny Rogers is a singer, songwriter, and multi-instrumentalist who was born and bred in Lodi, a small Northern California town. At age 6, she became obsessed with skateboarding and even thought she wanted to pursue her passion professionally. She grew up in the church with her father who is a youth pastor who and listened to AC/DC and Mexican mother who listened to Mariachi music -- Destiny was pulled in by the power of music. At age 9, she received her first guitar and by age 10 taught herself how to play by watching Justin Bieber covers online and began singing.

After a few years of busking in Los Angeles on the weekends and facing the trials and tribulations of the music industry, she connected with the Grammy-Award winning songwriter/producer team The Stereotypes (Bruno Mars, Cardi B, Justin Bieber). She signed to their label, Beach Wave Sound in 2018 and released her R&B and hip-hop inflected pop debut EP *Tomboy* via Beach Wave Sound/RCA Records the following year.

Destiny has performed at various festivals including Something in the Water, Lights On and Tyler, The Creator's Camp Flog Gnaw, as well as on a European and North American tour with Ruel.

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
About Flo Milli:

21-year old, Alabama born rapper, **Flo Milli** has taken the Internet by storm in her short accent. Releasing her first official track "Beef FloMix" on her SoundCloud in late 2018, she had gone viral by early 2019 on TikTok, marking her breakout success and she hasn't let up since. Known for her bubbly delivery and aggressive bars, in July 2020 she took the internet by storm once again with the release of her debut mixtape, *Ho, why is you here ?* On the project, Flo exudes unapologetic confidence and empowers females with her experiences shared in her music, making her a relatable youth figure. Standout tracks from the project include the SWV-sampling "Weak" and "May I." The mixtape received great critical support upon release landing on the covers of Spotify's "Feelin Myself" playlist and Apple Music's "On Repeat," along with two Spotify New Music Friday billboards last summer. She received rave reviews in the press from the likes of *New York Magazine*, *Pitchfork*, *Rolling Stone*, *Complex*, *FADER* and *NYLON*, with many calling her the next female rapper to break through and coining *Ho, why is you here ?* as one of the best projects of 2020. Other accolades include her first ever award show nomination for Best New Artist at the BET Hip-Hop Awards where she performed as part of the cypher.

Following the BET Hip-Hop Awards and breaking into 2021, she was named a VEVO DSCVR Artist for 2021 and Spotify's latest RADAR Artist. Her first release of the year is her *Fiddler On The Roof* sampling, Kenny Beats produced, "Roaring 20s" which is accompanied by a dance-filled, flapper visual. Most recently, Flo was nominated for Best New Artist at the 2021 BET Awards and was an inductee of XXL's 2021 Freshman Class.
